ITEMS THAT ARE PICKED UP BY THE TOWN:

Appliances, bicycles, metal, bundled brush, and bagged leaves.

Brush with a diameter of 6" or less must be in max 8-foot lengths. Brush with a diameter of 6" or greater must be in max 4-foot lengths.

To arrange for a pickup, please call or email the Highway Department for an appointment. Pickups are usually on Fridays. Please include the following information in your email or voicemail: your name, address, phone number, and the item(s) you need picked up. You will not receive a call back unless there is a question.

Leave the items by the curb before 7am Friday morning.

ITEMS THAT ARE NOT PICKED UP BY THE TOWN:

Furniture, batteries, mattresses, construction debris, concrete and grass clippings (Depending on the item, your garbage carter may pick up. Contact your carter for more information.)

ITEMS THAT CAN BE DROPPED OFF AT THE HIGHWAY GARAGE:

Appliances, furniture, mattresses, metal items, brush, <u>bagged</u> leaves and <u>bagged</u> grass clippings.

An annual permit is required for all items other than metal, bagged grass, leaves, and brush. The permit can be purchased for \$20 at the Town Clerk's office at Town Hall - Monday-Friday 8am to 4:30pm.

Drop off hours are Monday-Friday 8am- 3:00pm; Saturday 8am- 1pm.

Bio-degradable bags for leaves and grass are available for free at the highway garage during the months of March/April and September/October WHILE SUPPLIES LAST.

Please note: it is highly recommended to use mulch blades to break down your grass clippings rather than bagging

NOTE: For all other items, or if you are doing any renovation work on your home, you must call your private garbage carter for a container. THE TOWN HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WILL NOT PICK UP OR ACCEPT CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS.

CONTRACTORS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DROP OFF.

ITEMS THAT ARE ACCEPTED AT THE POMONA HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY:

Paint, chemicals, batteries, electronics, and TVs. (See website for hours, location and more information.) https://www.rocklandgreen.com/residents/household-hazardous-waste/

HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE:
